

4% of jobs in Hull and East **Yorkshire** are in the creative and digital sector



The creative and digital sector is extremely broad, and encompasses a wide range of activities including telecoms, graphic design, digital marketing, computer programming, computer games design, virtual reality and social media.

Did You Know?

- Between 2011 and 2022, the number of jobs in the UK's creative industries grew by 54% to 2.4 million.
- Over 36% of jobs in the digital technology economy are in nontechnical occupations, like product management, user experience, legal, people, and sales.
- There are approximately 635 creative and digital companies in Hull and East Yorkshire, 90% of them employ less than 10 members of staff.
- The number of jobs working for computer consultancy businesses in Hull and East Yorkshire has grown by 71% in the last 7 years to approximately 1,800.
- Around one third of the creative and digital sector's workforce are self-employed.
